

How To Make An Altered Clipboard

The Basic Necessities!

- Clipboard
- Mod Podge
- Scrapbook Papers
- Acrylic Paint
- Foam Brush
- Plate holder or frame holder
- Embellishments of choice (Chipboard, ribbons, fibers, etc.)
- Scissors
- Photo of choice

Directions:

- Paint any exposed areas of your clipboard. (If you will be covering your clipboard with paper you will only need to paint the edges.)
- Rip, Tear, Cut, etc. your papers and adhere them to your clipboard using Mod Podge. (Apply 2 or 3 coats of Mod Podge, allowing to dry between each coating.)
- Adhere the photo to the front of the clip board. (For best results- Mat your photo on cardstock first then adhere to clipboard. It is not recommended to use Mod Podge OVER the photo. Simply apply your favorite adhesive to the back of the mat and adhere to the clipboard.)
- Add any embellishments.
- Tie ribbon, fiber, etc. to the clip.

Other Uses for your Altered Clipboard:

- Use as a Photo Frame
- Use for Notes
- Make an advent calendar
- Give away as gifts (Teachers LOVE them)
- Use as a Calendar
- Use for a shopping list
- Make a collage board for Grandparents

Additional Tips:

- Use a small clipboard to hold Post-It Notes, Phone Slips, Etc.
- Paint the Clip
- Decorate BOTH sides
- Add tags, die cuts, etc. to your clipboard
