

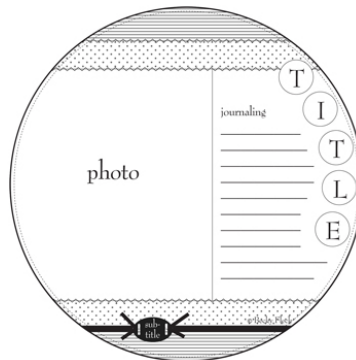
How To Make An Altered Clock

The Basic Necessities!

- An inexpensive round clock (that the face can be removed)
- Adhesive
- Paper of choice
- Scissors
-
- 5 chipboard coasters
- Ribbon or fiber
- Sanding Tool
- Hole Punch
- Scissors

Directions:

- Remove the second, minute and hour hands by lifting them straight up. (Do not bend the hands)
- Use the outer face rim to trace a circle of paper.
- Cut out and adhere to the face of the clock (mark the center with a small dot)
- Use the small dot as a guide, cut out a circle where the clock hands will poke through.
- Embellish Clock As Desired



- Now re-install the clock hands. (Hour, Minute, then second)
- Replace glass

Clock Tips:

- You can add photos etc. to your clock.
- Ink edges etc.
- Don't use thick embellishments the clock hands will need to move freely.
- Make sure to clean inside of glass before replacing, to remove any smudges you may have gotten on glass.
- Set the time
- Enjoy!
