

## **How To Make A Mixed Media Mini Album**

Mixed media mini albums are taking scrap booking by storm. There is no specific way to do it. That's what makes them so great... Imagine That! We do suggest choosing your front and back cover with either chipboard or acrylic.

### **The Basic Necessities!**

- 2 pieces of 6x6 chipboard or acrylic
- Paper of choice
- Embellishments of choice
- Media of choice
- Paper trimmer
- Adhesive
- Jump Rings
- Hole Punch

### **Directions:**

- Place all your media in pages (Using all different sizes and shapes)
- Punch hole (or holes for jump ring)
- Add jump rings (Or spirals)
- Embellish as desired
- Add photos
- Tie ribbon or fiber on jump rings

### **Mixed Media Tips:**

- You can add tags, die cuts, coffee filters, frames, cd's, acrylics, envelopes, paper bags, x-rays, fabric, journal cards, transparencies, old driver's licenses, library cards, playing cards, leather pieces, mesh, postcards, thin metal, woods, etc. to your album.
- You can ink edges
- You can make any size album. Just make sure your front and back covers are a little bigger than the inside pages. (Ex. 8X8, 6X6, 5X5, etc.)
- Be creative and let your imagination take off. Use your imagination to come up with many ideas.
