

How To Make A Photo Box

The Basic Necessities!

- Four – 12x12 sheets of cardstock
- Embellishments of choice
- Paper Trimmer
- Adhesive
- Ruler

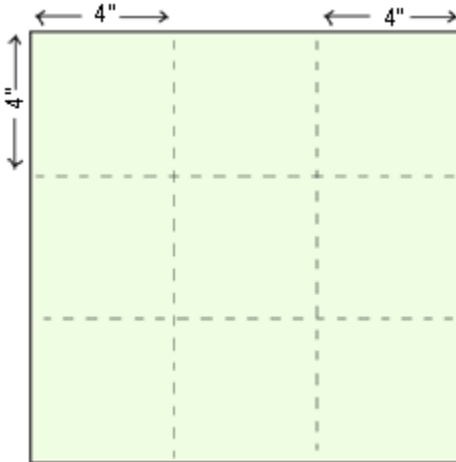
Directions:

Take your 3 sheets of cardstock and trim them to size as per below: (1 12X12, 1 11X11, and 1 10X10)

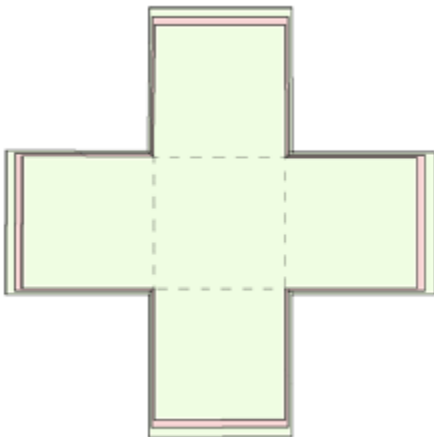
- Take your FIRST sheet of cardstock (Bottom layer of box) (12 X 12)
- Then layer your SECOND sheet of cardstock on top of first sheet. (11 X 11)
- Then layer your THIRD sheet of cardstock on top of the 2nd sheet. (10 X 10)

Score 4 folds on each card layer. (See diagram)

- Score the 12X12 cardstock (1st layer) 4” in from sides
- Score the 11X11 cardstock (2nd layer) 3 ¾” in from sides
- Score the 10X10 cardstock (3rd layer) 3 ½” in from sides



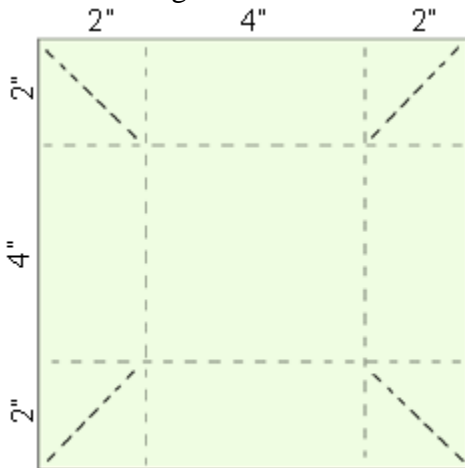
- Cut out the corners from all 3 sheets. (See diagram)



- Embellish each of the panels as desired (Note- you can embellish both side or just the top)
- Create pockets for hidden items, tags, etc.
- Add ribbons, fibers, photos, etc.
- When finished embellishing your box, adhere the “bases” together

Now Make the Lid:

- Trim your last sheet of cardstock 8” X 8”
- Score each side 2” in (NOTE- Do NOT cut out the corner squares)
- Fold and glue



Box Tips:

- You can add tags, die cuts, embellishments etc. to the outside of your box.
- Add shredded paper to the bottom of your box before adding gift. (Candy etc.)
- Use your imagination to come up with many ideas.
- Add photos to the outside OR inside of your box.
- After folding and gluing the box lid, use clips to secure until dry.
